States Won: Obama 28, McCain 22

Electoral Votes: Obama 365, McCain 173

Obama won one of five electoral votes in Nebraska, which is one of two states (Maine is the other) that does not use a "winner-take-all" system of awarding electoral votes. Those states instead award two electoral votes to the statewide popular vote winner and one electoral vote to the winner of each congressional district. Obama won Nebraska's Omaha-centered 2nd District.

Some states have amended their official results. Percentages may not add exactly to 100 because of rounding. The District of Columbia is not a state but votes for president and has three electoral votes.
